Abortion Recovery

“Lisa’s” story is about her past abortion. It seems a relevant story to share as we are likely to have women choosing abortion after being affected by the Coronavirus. After getting an adverse prenatal diagnosis, Lisa ended up getting an abortion. She said:

The reason I didn’t get my abortion until the second trimester was that my Christian family had never faced anything like this before. We were blindsided by the news from the doctor and needed time to come to grips with what was happening. I wanted to talk to Christian leaders I trusted.

So we turned to our church. My aunt and uncle were missionaries in Taiwan at the time, but they were home on furlough. As a missionary nurse, my aunt agreed with my parents’ Sunday school teacher—a Chief of Cardiac Surgery at a major hospital—that this abortion was within God’s will. They told me that this was a “technology that God has given us in order to prevent more suffering in the world.” On their advice, I went ahead with the procedure.

Although I seldom talk about my abortion, I spent a lot of years being very angry...

Oh my gosh, killing the unborn to prevent suffering...that is an example of sin dulling the intellect. This story reflects the culture of death and shows a different perspective on why women are suffering from the trauma of abortion.
